### Summary of Annual Returns of Lodges Year Ended 31st December 2020

The Annual Lodge Returns show an overall decrease in membership of 11 during 2020. This represents a decrease of 2.16% on the 2019 figures.

We must ensure that every one of our Mark Lodge members is aware that the Royal Ark Mariner Degree should be the next step in their Masonic development. Each Mark Lodge now has a nominated Lodge Representative to encourage members to join the Royal Ark Mariner Degree. However, we should all remember that we are all recruiters of new members.
