#### Summary of Annual Returns of Lodges Year Ended 31st December 2021

The Annual Lodge Returns show an overall decrease in membership of 23. This represents a decrease from last year of 4.61%. The overall trend over the last 5 years is a decrease of 17.93% from 580 members.

Recruitment of new members is so important if we are to grow our membership base, as well as doing everything possible to try to reduce the number of resignations.

Now that we are able to meet again, let's see if this year's downward trend can be reversed by encouraging more of our Mark Lodge members to join this friendly and colourful degree.
