

Mordaunt Cohen was advanced into the Union Mark Lodge No. 124 on 22 November 1958 and became Worshipful Master of Union Mark in 1972. He Moved to London 1989. He became an Honorary Member at the presentation of his 50 Year Certificate on 24 November 2008.

A Jewish officer commanding African Muslims in Burma, Lieutenant Colonel Mordaunt Cohen served in Burma with 251 West African Heavy Anti-Aircraft Unit, commanding Nigerian volunteers.

Mr Cohen was awarded an MBE for his work teaching in schools about the Second World War, and for a series of films recorded to mark VJ Day. He said: 'I am deeply humbled and honoured to receive this award. When I was commanding troops many miles from here, in very tough conditions, never did I even imagine that aged 101, I would receive such an honour.

It is my mission to make sure that future generations will understand what our armed forces went through, so that we can all live freely and in peace in this country.

'As a British Jewish veteran, I'm especially proud of the immense contribution made by the 60,000 Jewish soldiers who served our country in World War Two.

'I would like to dedicate this award to the soldiers who didn't come home, and who sadly paid the ultimate sacrifice.' (source - web)

The Provincial Grand Master was pleased to visit the charity SHAID, which is the Single Homeless Action Initiative in Durham, at their Headquarters in Sacriston to present a cheque for a £1000 on behalf of the Province of Durham Mark Benevolent Fund.

This Charity supports young single homeless, but also maintains a 16 unit residence for homeless ex-service personel and plans to increase capacity to 35 units.

A supporter of the charity, WBro. Joe Dodson, was on hand to accompany RWBro.Prof. Denovan Keith Wilson together with the Benevolent Fund Treasurer, VWBro.Roy Neville in making this important presentation to Tony Hammond who is the Project Manager of St.Peter's Court.

The team was given a tour of the building by Tony and had the opportunity to meet with one of it's residents who kindly agreed to show them round his apartment. He told them of his previous life as a homeless person living in a tent and how much his life has changed with this new and safe home where he is able to plan his future in a much more positive way. He is actively looking for work and feels having a proper "home address" gives him a huge advantage in his quest.
